December 2021 marked the 5th edition of Prishtina International Theater Festival, which brought theater troupes from Turkey, Bulgaria, Serbia, Northern Macedonia, Albania, and Kosovo, to the stages of both "Faruk Begolli" theaters, as the only international theater festival in the country, organized by yours truly.

Furthermore, many other cultural activities were also organized, such as the awarding of the International Prize for Literature "Ali Podrimja", given to the Bosnian writer Abdullah Sidran, the Academy marking the 85th anniversary of the birth of academician Rexhep Qosja, or the visit of the President of Albania, Ilir Meta on the eve of November 28, National Flag Day.

During this year, we have also achieved great results in the advancement and digitalization of services at AAB College. Online learning in pandemic conditions and especially the digitalization of the platform for the administration of diploma theses, mark a practice unique to AAB College that cannot be found elsewhere in the region. Graduates can now carry out a considerable part of their diploma work remotely, saving their precious time that previously had to be spent on administrative procedures. The process of digitalization of services at AAB College will remain a priority in the future as well.

In the new issue 9/2 of the international scientific journal "Thesis", according to the vice-rector for scientific research, Hasan Saliu, 16 scientific articles have been published by researchers and professors from the University of Leicester, University of Osaka, Polytechnic University of Milan, UNIJU of Sao Paolo, University de Puebla Brazil, from Mexico, University of Technology in Maryland, University of Bucharest, AAB College as well as from several other universities in the region.

"Thesis" is an international scientific journal of AAB College indexed on international platforms such as DOAJ, Worldcat, Base Bielefield, Erich Plus, Hrcak, Core, MIAR, CEEOL and over 30 libraries of Western European universities.

Book "Serbian crimes in Kosovo" promoted at AAB College

The book "Serbian Crimes in Kosovo" by Çerçiz Loloçi was promoted at the Media Center of AAB College.

This book reflects the crimes committed during the war in Kosovo and is divided into 4 chapters. The book "Serbian Crimes in Kosovo", which was first published 12 years ago with the title "Holocaust, the file without comment on Milosevic's crimes", was highly praised by its readers and critics.









The author of the book, Çerçiz Loloçi, said that this is a modest contribution which serves to help us remember the crimes, to denounce them, and to be wiser in protecting our rights", adding that the time has come for the academies of sciences to work more in this field.

Jury members observed the discussion for the duration of 90 minutes.

The jury then contributed to the discussion and evaluated the student's performance while also giving tips on how to further improve their debating skills in the future.

The book "Success of sales management" by Shpëtim Memishi was promoted today at AAB College. In this book, the author explains the concepts of sales management, with particular focus on the process of sales management self-efficacy.



"Success of sales management" is divided into six parts and fourteen chapters, and brings a completely practical approach through which the author touches on the full cycle of the sales management process, from the planning, organization, communication, process and negotiation techniques up to sales analysis and evaluation.





During his speech, the professor of the Faculty of Economics, Ilir Rexhepi, among others, said that a special feature of this book in terms of content, in addition to the scientific context, is how the author melds practical experience with the examples, case studies, concepts, methods, instruments and sales techniques. All of these factors make for a book that will have no trouble selling itself.

"This book is a skillfully honed instrument with an alternative and practical approach that will serve not only students but also all others who partake in sales management, to advance their practical professional training in order to manage sales better, and have greater success in the process of selling products or services" said Rexhepi.

The Dean of the Faculty of Economics, Medain Hashani, highly praised the work of the author Shpëtim Memishi, while also saying that AAB College is proud that Memishi has completed his studies in economics in both the bachelor and master's level here at AAB College, amongst us.

The organization currently has more than 150 members from inside and outside the EU and acts as an international forum for discussing many legal topics related to legal education.

The purpose of this meeting was to strengthen the cooperation between the National Audit Office and AAB College in the field of auditing, to exchange professional and academic assistance, as well as to provide students with more internship opportunities.

During his visit at AAB College, the Auditor General, Besnik Osmani, also had a discussion with the students of the Faculty of Economics, where he explained the role, the mission, how the National Audit Office works, as well as other details of the process of compiling audit reports.



Osmani said that the KAO audits public funds to assure taxpayers that their money is being used economically, that financial reporting is accurate and decisions are in line with legal requirements. The Auditor General further emphasized the importance of implementing the KAO recommendations and their impact on strengthening good governance and accountability.





During this discussion, the students showed a lot of interest in the auditing process, the security of the audit, the types of audits, the accountability and transparency of the spending of public money.

Meanwhile, the Dean of the Faculty of Economics at AAB College, Mr. Medain Hashani, thanked the Auditor General for the visit, emphasizing the importance of cooperation between the two institutions. Hashani said that the KAO continues to be among the most credible institutions in Kosovo through professional, independent and transparent work.

Organized by the Office for International Relations of AAB College, a virtual roundtable was held with representatives of partner universities from the Republic of Turkey.

In this meeting, the Rector of AAB College, Bujar Demjaha spoke about the importance of implementing and intensifying the agreements reached to further deepen cooperation.



The roundtable also discussed the achievements of cooperation not only with educational institutions from Turkey but also European ones.

Vice Rector Venera Llunji spoke about the ERASMUS + and MEVLANA projects and about the difficulties that our institution has encountered during the pandemic period.





She stressed that the pandemic can hinder travel and direct contact in higher education institutions but cannot affect cooperation through the use of various virtual communication platforms.

Education reforms – important factor in the reduction of skill gap

26 March 2021

The Vice Rector for International Cooperation and Relations, Venera Llunji, was part of a virtual forum organized by the American Chamber of Commerce, which discussed the need for education reform and the lack of skills of young people graduating from higher education.





This virtual forum discussed the high unemployment rate among young people in our country, despite the high number which are enrolled in or have completed their university education. According to the panelists, this fact is an indicator that reflects the discrepancy between the skills offered by the education system and those required by employers.

Vice Rector Llunji, when addressing the issue of skill discrepancy, stressed that in such a situation no one factor can be blamed specifically for the skill gap, because all levels of the education system are interconnected links. She also touched on the disturbing situation of education in Kosovo, where she said that it has dropped drastically at every level, citing the so-called functional illiteracy as a very negative factor present in Kosovo.

According to Llunji, it is good to have cooperation between educational institutions and businesses, in order to identify market demands and create educational programs that match it.

AAB College-part of the virtual meeting "European universities 2030: vision and values", organized by the Magna Charta Observatory

27 March 2021

The Vice Rector for International Cooperation and Relations, Venera Llunji, participated in the virtual meeting "European Universities 2030: Vision and Values", organized by the Magna Charta Observatory.



The purpose of this meeting was to analyze two important documents issued by MCHO and the European University Association: the new Magna Charta Universitatum (MCU2020) and the "Universities without walls – a vision for 2030" report.

In February 2021, as one of the two founders of the Magna Charta Observatory, the European University Association published a report titled 'Universities without walls – a vision for 2030'. The report is based on extensive consultations with individuals, expert groups and actors. The report contains topics such as the sustainability and agenda of the United Nations by 2030, digital transformation, geopolitical situations and global tensions, and the impact of Covid 19.

Precisely because of these "seismic" movements and fundamental challenges that affect universities, it is all the more reason for universities to stand firm and maintain their core values, such as academic freedom, institutional autonomy and scientific integrity.

In 2020, this international body issued a new document called the new Magna Charta Universitatum (MCU2020), which examines and considers the changes in higher education from the time that the original document was released in 1988 up until 2020, and predicts the difficulties that universities will go through in 2020 and beyond.

Prof. Lunji contributed in the implementation of the strategies of these two documents and the method in which universities can balance the strategic orientation of their activities towards great social goals by emphasizing academic freedom and the individual freedom of researchers.

AAB College signs cooperation agreement with Kosovo Insurance Bureau

30 March 2021

A cooperation agreement was signed between AAB College and the Kosovo Security Bureau on the premises of AAB College. The agreement was signed by Rector Dr.Sc. Bujar Demjaha, and Sami Mazreku, executive director of the Kosovo Security Bureau.





The purpose of this agreement is to establish professional cooperation in the field of insurance, organization of professional training on insurance such as insurance basics, risk management, risk analysis, life and non-life insurance products, reinsurance, marketing, and sales channels, and to have joint lectures in training for insurance mediators and other professional training.

In addition, thanks to this agreement, the parties agreed on the joint organization of debate and scientific roundtables, where issues of interest will be addressed, such as discussions on the development of the financial insurance market, insurance market analysis and impact on the economy, trends in insurance – systems and product development, etc.

Workshop held with students of the Faculty of Mass Communication on "Gender responsible budgeting"

31 March 2021

The Faculty of Mass Communication, in cooperation with the Association of Journalists of Kosovo, supported by UN Women, in the framework of the regional project "Transformational Financing for Gender Equality towards more transparent, inclusive and accountable governance in the Western Balkans" funded by SIDA, organized a workshop with AAB College students on the topic "Gender Responsive Budgeting".





The workshop organized with the students of the Faculty of Communication had the following objectives:

- Enabling students to report on Gender Responsive Budgeting in Kosovo in an impartial, gender sensitive and ethical manner.
- Increasing awareness and understanding of gender inequalities in Kosovo.
- Expanding students' knowledge of how gender inequalities can be addressed through GRB.
- Supporting students in developing concrete ideas and methodologies for drafting GRB reports.

Gender Responsive Budgeting (GRB) is a term often used by Civil Society Organizations (CSOs), international donors, and government officials.

Kosovo has a strong legal framework that supports and obligates all institutions at the local and central level to implement Gender Responsive Budgeting.

Even though GRB is a legal obligation that is expected to be implemented by public institutions, its implementation levels remain low.





The day's activities were concluded with the exhibition of the Faculty of Graphic Design and Multimedia students.



Ambassador Aliferi: Greece strongly supports visa liberalization for Kosovo

The Head of the Greek Diplomatic Office in Kosovo, Ambassador Chryssoula Aliferi, began the lecture on "Greek Foreign Policy", with the history of Greece and the Greek nation, the history of the formation of the Balkan nations and the historical developments of this territory.





Ambassador Aliferi also spoke about the parliamentary system of Greece, which has the same as the system as Kosovo.

Speaking about the recognition of Kosovo by Greece, Ambassador Aliferi said that Greece has not yet recognized Kosovo, but they care about Kosovo, even more than some countries that have recognized us.

"We have not recognized you as a country, but we care, we care a lot, and sometimes we care more than some countries who have recognized Kosovo. I am thankful for the office, as I am the ambassador to the country. Greece has been here through NATO, KFOR, Eulex. We had our people in UNMIK as well. We have helped Kosovo join specific international organizations. We recognize Kosovo passports and issue visas. We want visas removed. We have to wait for the decisions of our partners. "We strongly favor visa liberalization for Kosovo" said Aliferi.



At the end of the lecture, in the discussion session with the students, the career diplomat Chryssoula Aliferi, also spoke about the Kosovo-Serbia dialogue, saying that they support an EU-mediated dialogue, which would bring an ultimate solution to the matter. "Good results will pave the way for many things. As for compromises, do not ask us, because we made our compromises years ago. Life goes on, but you have to think about your future and the future of your children. Let your leaders be generous towards the opposite side." The lecture with the Greek Ambassador was organized as a part of the modules "Foreign Policy" and "History of Diplomacy", which are lectured by Prof. Nehmedin Spahiu within the Faculty of Public Administration.

Faculty of Psychology celebrates Mental Health Awareness week

15 May 2021

As part of the mental health awareness week, organized by the Faculty of Psychology of AAB College and the Clinic "Empatia", a Roundtable Discussion was held in AAB College with professionals of the field, on the topic "Understanding mental health / Reflections in a time of pandemic"





in the opening of this roundtable, The Dean of the Faculty of Psychology, Prof. Naim Telaku, revealed some of the most significant statistics in terms of mental health, published by the WHO.



According to Telaku, the field of mental health, although ignored by many, according to various statistics, is one area in which people need help the most.

He said that according to the WHO, about 10% of the world's population is affected by mental illness, and this number can be as high as 20% in poor countries. Of these, about 264 million people suffer from depression, 45 million from bipolar disorder, 20 million from schizophrenia, and dementia affects about 50 million people worldwide.

Mental health problems are also the cause of suicides, providing a disturbing statistic especially among 15–29-year-olds, where suicide is the second leading cause of death globally. In this age group, every 40 seconds, a young person commits suicide in the world.

Another problem that Dean Telaku pointed out is the low level of awareness about the nature of mental health problems in the general population and also in various institutions.





He also stressed that there is a significant increase in the occurrence of anxiety in the population, where according to him, due to the Covid-19 pandemic, the level of anxiety has increased by 30-50%.

Psychologist Shqipe Ukshini, from UCCK, an invited guest to this roundtable, said that the increase of mental health problems is proportionally related to the increase in population and overcrowding of urban settlements.

Meanwhile, psychologist Fitim Uka, from the Clinic "Empatia", and also an invited guest, said that unlike a decade ago, the perspective in the treatment of these diseases has changed, because today, people talk more openly about their mental health and concerns. "I am convinced that with this new era of psychology in Kosovo, we will no longer talk only about the treatment of mental disorders, but also about their prevention," said Uka.

Psychologist Shkurtë Bajgora, from the psychological support line "Mbështetu", who also participated in this roundtable discussion, explained that there are cases who call to talk about their anxiety, panic attacks, personal concerns in the family or with friends.

Students of Child care and Welfare program visit Learning centers for learning and advice in Prizren

21 May 2021

A group of students from the Faculty of Social Sciences, Child Care and Welfare program, together with Professor Dr. Sc. Sevim Mustafa, visited the Resource Centers for Learning and Counseling "Lef Nosi" and "Mother Teresa" in Prizren.





The students were informed in detail about the learning process of children with hearing and speech impairments. They got to closely watch the children and their communication with teachers and peers through sign language and the assistance of a sign language interpreter.

The teaching takes place in the same way as in all schools in Kosovo, based on the curriculum, but adapts to the individual needs of each child through an Individual Education Plan which is reviewed twice a year.

These visits were deemed very useful for the students, as they received a lot of information on the work being done and the great dedication of the staff so that the children can achieve success and also integrate themselves into regular schools.

What is the best way to learn English, through learning or acquisition?

22 May 2021

As part of the consecutive activities of the English Language Faculty Student Debate Club, the recent debate addressed the topic of English language learning.

The project is towards completion, and at the end of it, there will be organized a workshop which will take place at AAB College, where in addition to project funders and administrators, it will be attended by representatives of institutions of the Republic of Kosovo, but also women representatives of the respective industry.

Criminalistics Students Of Aab College, Part Of ISRD4 Research Project

10 June 2021

In the framework of the international research project on juvenile delinquency, ISRD4 (The International Self-Report Delinquency Study), students of the Criminalistics program of the Faculty of Law of AAB College are carrying out the survey in various schools in Kosovo municipalities.



This international project is being developed in cooperation with the Association of Criminologists, and Criminologists and Victimologists of Kosovo (ASKK), together with the international partners, University of Applied Sciences Zurich / Institute for Delinquency and Crime Prevention, Switzerland, Northeastern University College of Social Sciences and Humanities from the United States, and HETS-FR School for Social Work.

The ISRD4 project, which is a continuation of the previous three editions of this research, aims to provide early warning about deviant behaviors of juvenile delinquents.







This research is being done on the age group of children from 13 to 17 years old (students from grade 7 to 12th). The students of AAB College who are conducting the field research are being led by Prof. Mensut Ademi.

AAB Summer Project workshop held at AAB College

14 June 2021

As part of the AAB Summer Project, the Faculty of Psychology continued its weekly activities with a lecture which talked about the psychological services offered in the Department of Gynecology at UCCK and the Kosovo Correctional Service.



Guests at this event were Brikena Krasniqi-Hoti, psychotherapist and specialist in clinical psychology, and Arbër Zeka, psychotherapist specializing in group psychotherapy and positive psychotherapy, employed in the Kosovo Correctional Service.

The two psychologists shared their very valuable experiences they had during their internships, which garnered a lot of interest from the students who asked numerous questions about the topics discussed.

Psychologist Brikena Krasniqi-Hoti stressed that the need for a psychologist in the gynecological ward is extremely important given the fragile nature of women, which is constantly in a kind of psychological transition from pregnancy to the post-natal phase, and receiving psychological help in these cases is more than necessary for their psychological well-being.







Meanwhile, psychologist Arbër Zeka, also shared a lot of interesting information, explaining once again the importance of the psychologist in the Kosovo Correctional Service, saying that the psychological assistance provided by psychologists in this institution has only just started preventing suicides in 2020, where, approximately, 40 suicide attempts by prisoners have been recorded thus far.

Zeka pointed out that these statistics are constantly updated, and are also published online on the website of the relevant institution, which students can freely use for research in the field of psychology.

On the other hand, in the framework of the project "AAB Summer Project", students, together with their mentors, discussed their next research steps. Dean Naim Telaku emphasized the importance of the project, whereas additional clarifications of the methodology were given by Prof. Shpend Voca. Currently, research groups are in the phase of selecting relevant topics and variables.

At the end of today's activity, Dean Telaku told the students and those present that the international psychologist Dr. Mariel Leclère will be invited to the next meeting and will speak about EEG Electroencephalography and Neurofeedback.

Former student of AAB College, now winner of the award "Innovation of the year" as developer of the IBAS platform in PBC

Professor from France, Dr. Mariel Leclere holds lecture for AAB College students on electroencephalography and neuro-feedback

18 June 2021

The activities of the AAB Summer Project have continued this week as well. Today the students of the Faculty of Psychology, the Faculty of Computer Science and the Faculty of Mass Communication, had the opportunity to attend a very interesting lecture and demonstration by French Professor Dr. Mariel Leclere on electroencephalography and neuro-feedback.



During this lecture, students were introduced to this advanced technique of reflecting electromagnetic waves of the brain known as (EEG).

Dr. Leclere introduced the numerous applications of this technique to the students, such as the reflection of brain waves in people, which finds use in clinical cases of sleep disorders. By the end of the lecture, the students also had the opportunity to operate the EEG apparatus.







The presentation closed with the application of the neuro-feedback method through which one can intervene in the regulation of brain waves in cases of mental disorders. When the lecture was at its end, students had the opportunity to ask questions on imaging brain work through EEG and research methods within Neuroscience.

The activity ended with a workshop on research projects and a discussion of the program for the coming weeks.


What makes us even more proud is how well our students are being received by German employers, thanks to the professional preparation by AAB College, and the teaching of German and other languages by the Lingua staff.

The decision for the International Prize for Literature "Ali Podrimja", for the Bosnian writer Abdullah Sidran, was by a jury composed of: Halil Matoshi, Naime Begiraj, Lulzim Tafa, Rrahman Paçarizi and Vlora Konushevci.







The reason of the jury, which was given by Halil Matoshi, was that this Prize is awarded to the writer Abdullah Sidran, for his great art given the highest evaluations and considerations for him. While the prize was awarded to the winner of 2021 by the Rector of AAB College, Bujar Demjaha.

At the solemn ceremony of the "Ali Podrimja" Award, the laureate of 2021, gave an emotional speech in front of the audience.

"People usually think that every shell taken from the bottom of the sea holds a pearl in it. But not every shell has a pearl. Only those shells that have experienced an external shock have pearls, those that have suffered severe wounds in their body, and to heal that wound, they secrete such fluid that later turns into pearls.



Our talents have been born from a tear, our pearls have been born from our wounds and I want everyone here to understand this as a truth that relates to the individual and as a truth that relates to our nations, our collectivities.

What is most beautiful in them, is that they are born from the wounds of our nations and our people. And let us hope that the current scars that we have and that we are going through ,in the future will yield wonderful and beautiful pearls that will be the pride of the people.

Thank you to everyone. I am really a happy man tonight," said Sidran.

"From Dilemmas To The Results Of A Scientific Research. How To Answer Research Questions" Was The Topic Discussed In AAB Summer Project

2 July 2021

The following activity within the AAB Summer Project, which has gathered students from the Faculties of Psychology, Computer Science and Mass Communication, brought a thematic lecture to the best professors in scientific research work such as: Fitim Uka, PhD, Shpend Voca, PhD and Arian Musliu, PhD cand.



Characteristics of cross-sectional studies suitable for descriptive analysis and simple linear analysis, was the topic for which Arian Musliu lectured. Among other things, he stressed the possibility of cross-sectional studies in Kosovo based on the fact that we are a developing country in the center of the Balkans (EU) with a very young average age.







While Shpend Voca addressed the topic of P-hacking, which according to him the total value of p, in the process of statistical analysis is manipulated in an unfair way. In terms of analysis, a parallel has been drawn between SPSS (Statistical Package for Social Sciences) and Studios R and Mplus. These two softwares, like the latest trends used for statistical analysis have some advantages because they offer deeper analysis than can be provided with SPSS.

Whereas, prof. Fitim Uka has also shared his own experiences from research work to make more accurate measurements knowing that definitions in the field of psychology may vary among themselves and not all can be answered with a single scientific method.

This session was moderated by Vice Dean Mimoza Kamberi, who also led the discussion between students and panelists, and at the very end the next activity within this project was announced, which will be held on July 9, 2021.

Students of career and employment program take additional trainings to prepare for license exam in Germany

AAB Summer Project discussed the experiences of trauma and torture and their psychological effects on the population who experienced war in Kosovo

9 July 2021

The summer research project "AAB Summer Project", this week continued with a new topic, which discussed the experiences of trauma and torture and their psychological effects on the population that has experienced the war in Kosovo.





In addition to the students and academic staff involved in this research project, invited to today's discussion were also Ms. Selvie Izeti Çarkaxhiu from the Rehabilitation Center of Torture Survivors (KRCT) and Mr. Korab Krasnigi from the ZFD Forum.

Selvie Izeti Çarkaxhiu (KRCT) is involved in promoting human rights for all ethnic groups in Kosovo in response to the need for psycho-social support for survivors of torture and trauma during the Kosovo war (1998-1999).





In the meantime, Selvie Izeti Çarkaxhiu emphasized the individual stigmas that traumatized people attribute to themselves and social stigmas. Whereas, the findings from the research implemented by this center and in cooperation with countries such as Australia and Denmark have alluded to the phenomenon of transmitting trauma to others based on cortisol levels.

The guest of today's activity was also Mr. Krasniqi from ZFD Forum. This organization supports people to face violent conflicts in response to the Balkan crisis. They deal in more detail with the design, development and implementation of projects in order to deal with the past.

On this occasion, students were given the opportunity to reveal the summarized stories of survivors of the recent war in Kosovo entitled: "I want to be heard" and "Beyond pain towards courage". The latter also touches on the topic of interaction with the family, the community and the policymaking of the country.

Whereas, Professor Mimoza Shahini from AAB College, has reflected on the services provided by Kosovo for survivors of trauma and violence and has shared experiences from practical work. On the other hand, from the experience of research work has been pointed out that the wives of war veterans compared to the veteran himself and the child, are likely to have difficulties with their mental health. Therefore, they called for trauma to be addressed as a dimension and not necessarily as a categorization.

KRCT and forum ZFD on the occasion of this event, have donated several copies of two books published by these organizations "Beyond pain, towards courage" and "I want to be heard" for the rector, library and students of AAB College.

The activity is closed by leaving it to the next activity that will follow after a week.



The latest issue of Scientific Review THESIS with authors from prestigious universities now available

13 July 2021

The new issue of the international scientific journal Thesis, published by AAB College, has been released.



This issue includes 10 scientific articles written by authors from prestigious universities, such as:

University of Bielefeld, University College London, University Rome Tre, Vrije University of Brussels, Osaka University, Hellenic Open University, Kaplan Higher Education Singapore, AAB College and South East European University.

The first article written by Greek, German and Singaporean authors deals with the use of face masks in education as a result of the Covid-19 pandemic.

The second article, written by English scholar Hoyte-West, deals with multilingualism in the Western Balkans, with a particular focus on translation and interpretation.

Another article deals with a similar topic, which elaborates the mistakes of Albanian students in Northern Macedonia when translating from Albanian to English. The scholar from Bielefeld treats the German concept of "bildung" according to Adorno's critique. Another article, whose author is by Vrije University in Brussels, deals with the harmonization of Albanian legislation with that of the EU regarding defamation in the media.

Other articles also belong to the fields of social sciences and humanities, including some articles focused on the Balkans.

Thesis is an international scientific journal which is published twice a year, online and in paper, indexed on dozens of international platforms.

The latest issue can also be read online, as AAB College adheres to and supports the European principle of open access to research.

AAB College remains the first and only Albanian nonpublic institution for citations in google scholar

14 July 2021

Out of about 5 thousand universities in the world, included in the #TransparentRanking, which is based on Google Scholar data, AAB College is ranked first non-public institution out of all Albanian institutions in Kosovo, Albania and Northern Macedonia.

AAB College remains yet again the only non-public institution from Kosovo that is included in this list, while from our country in this ranking only the University of Prishtina "Hasan Prishtina" is included.

Out of over 30 thousand world universities that are evaluated by this ranking, only the first 4 thousand are included in this ranking, as one of the top universities based on the publications of scholars and professors and their citation by other authors.



AAB College continues to be committed to the further development of the scientific research component, supporting and aiding the projects and research of the academic staff and students. This is evidenced by the International Scientific Journal "Thesis", which is published by AAB, and which is already indexed on about 50 scientific platforms, including: DOAJ, Hrcak, Base Bielefeld, MIAR, Worldcat, etc...

Transparent Ranking, as the list of top universities from Google Scholar citations is called, is published by the Spanish High Council for Scientific Research, part of which is also the research group Cybermetrix LAB.

13 students of AAB College attended the trainings and were certified for playdagogy byplay4international

15 July 2021

In cooperation with Play4 International, 13 students from the Faculty of Physical Education and Sports of AAB College, have been trained and certified and have acquired the skills to implement and lead PLAYDAGOGY sessions, from the handbook "Changing the mentality around disabilities". Students have implemented in practice 16 activities with over 100 children from the "British School of Kosova".





The PLAY'in Together project aims to work with European societies towards greater inclusion of all persons with disabilities, through the promotion of Paralympic and European Olympic (OPE) values in sporting games.





This project is implemented in 8 partner countries in Europe and is supported by the Erasmus + Sport Program, funded by the European Commission.

The runway of fashion design students was held with Victorian period costumes and the upcycle concept

AAB brings three international publications within the last three weeks

In the last three weeks alone, AAB College has issued three important scientific publications.

We're talking about the study book entitled "Role and legal position of the President of the Republic of Kosovo – 111 questions and answers", authors Besim Kajtazi and Florent Muçaj; The book with the works from the International Scientific Conference organized by AAB and in partnership with several other universities, as well as the international scientific journal "Thesis".



In the book for the role of the president, the authors provide answers to 111 questions related to the role and legal position of the president of Kosovo: how is the chairman of the CEC appointed and dismissed by the president of Kosovo?; what is the role of the president in foreign policy ?; how does the president represent the unity of the people ?; how does the president guarantee the democratic and constitutional functioning of Kosovo institutions, etc...

The book of the Conference includes 7 studies with 12 authors which were presented at the international scientific conference entitled "Perspectives of EU integration of the Western Balkans", which was held at AAB College in April, in cooperation with the University of Osijek, Sarajevo, South East European University, Durrës, FON-Skopje and Korça.

In this book the studies of the participants coming from the universities of Croatia, Turkey, Northern Macedonia, Kosovo, Albania, etc are published.

The third publication of AAB College that came out of print these days, is the international scientific journal "Thesis". The 280 pages of this volume include scholarly articles by scholars from prestigious universities around the world, such as: University College London, University of Rome Three, Vrije University of Brussels, Japanese University of Osaka, Hellenic Open University, Kaplan Higher Education Singapore, AAB College, German University Bielefeld, etc...

All three publications can be found in the Library of AAB College.

AAB College rises further on the ranks of Webometrics and continues to be the best Albanian non-public institution of higher education in the region

28 July 2021

447 positions higher than in the January 2021 edition of the prestigious ranking list of Webometrics, AAB College has again emerged as the best Albanian non-public institution in the region.



In the published results of Webometrics for the second edition of 2021, among over 30 thousand universities evaluated globally, the University of Prishtina and AAB College are ranked highest in our country.

The two leaders of the list of university institutions of Kosovo have had a remarkable increase in their position in the rank list, where the University of Prishtina rose by 247 positions, and AAB College rose 447 positions.

Based on these results, the highest ranked Albanian public universities are: University of Prishtina, University of Tirana, Agricultural University of Tirana, University of Tetova.

Webometrics, a ranking list conducted by the Cybermetrics Lab, which is part of the largest public research institution in Spain, the High Council for Scientific Research, recently released the list of 5 thousand best universities according to citations of scientific papers in Google Scholar, in which the only Institutions from our country that were included were the University of Prishtina and AAB College.

The ranking of Webometrics is based on the recognition of the published scientific works, as well as the content and dissemination of information from electronic sources by the relevant institutions.

The top rankings of World Universities are claimed by American universities, led by Harvard University, whereas the highest ranked university in Europe is that of Oxford.

The management team of AAB College, vice-rectors Shemsedin Vehapi, Uranela Demaj and the Dean of the Faculty of Physical Education, Fatmir Pireva, were joined in this conference by Mr. Lorik Cana, Attaché for Youth, Culture and Sports at the Albanian Embassy in Rome, and former captain of the Albanian Football National Team; Mrs. Silvija Mitevska, Sports Advisor to the Prime Minister of Northern Macedonia; Mr. Gavin Price, Bond University Australia, SOAS University of London and co-author of Towards a Welsh Sports Diplomacy Strategy; Mr. Grant Jarvie, University of Edinburgh and Toronto, former Adviser to the Scottish Government; Mrs. Albana Murra, AAB College alumni, marketing specialist; Mr. Loïc Tregoures, Catholic Institute of Paris, France, author of the book in French "Football in Yugoslav Chaos" and Mr. Juan Manuel Montoro, Kosovo Research and Analysis, PhD candidate at the University of Santiago de Compostela, Spain.





On this occasion, Vice Rector Shemsedin Vehapi said that this webinar is particularly important one, because it is taking place two or three days before the World Cup qualifying match of Kosovo Vs Spain. "We are taking small steps that will affect policy-makers in Kosovo and also in Spain. We as AAB College are ready to give all we can in our support of the sport.", said Vehapi.

Adnan Ahmeti from the Kosovo Institute for Sports said that although our country is only 13 years old, so far it has participated in two Olympics, and has won three medals, courtesy of our women athletes. "It is time for Kosovo to have its own strategy of sports diplomacy. This is a signal for Kosovo policymakers that they should do more for sports diplomacy and sports in general," said Ahmeti.





Lorik Cana, former captain of the Albanian National Football Team, currently attaché for youth, culture and sports at the Albanian Embassy in Rome, also spoke about the importance of sports in diplomacy. He said that football was his "voice" to promote national identity and lobby for our rights as a nation. "Diplomacy is a power of the people. When you have people with you who share your values, you have the power of diplomacy as an ambassador and representative of your country. We have to look no further than the case of Majlinda Kelmendi in Russia who became a judo champion representing Kosovo and the flag, which would be an impossible feat without sports ", said Cana.

In this webinar, it was concluded that sport remains a powerful tool to promote our country, our culture, and our values when we want to achieve the objectives of foreign policy as a state.

AAB COLLEGE CELEBRATES 150TH ANNIVERSARY OF THE BIRTH OF GJERGJ FISHTA

6 October 2021

Organized by AAB College in cooperation with the Albanian Institute of Sociology, the Publishing House "Gjergj Fishta" and the Publishing House "Drita", the Scientific Promotional Forum "Gjergj Fishta – life and writing" was held at AAB College.





This forum, among other activities was organized to mark the 150th anniversary of the birth of the national poet Gjergj Fishta, and aimed to present the polyhedral figure, contribution and multidimensional work of Gjergj Fishta, the presentation of the complete work with 10 volumes, as well as the promotion of the last two publications of the fishtologji fund.

At the opening of the forum, the Chairman of the Steering Council of AAB College, Lulzim Tafa, said that AAB not only as one of the largest universities in the region but also as one of the main cultural centers has considered it very important to mark this anniversary, although limited due to pandemic conditions.

Tafa said that Gjergj Fishta is one of the most emblematic figures of the Albanian nation. "In the creative field, Gjergj Fishta was undoubtedly a great writer.

His work became the inspiration for our battle and struggle for existence and freedom. In the field of action, Fishta was a great national activist, participant in many events that gave life to the processes of emancipation and national development. "He also emphasized the role of Fishta as a humanist and cleric, stressing that Fishta was a patriotic cleric and that religion was never divided from the homeland and the nation.



"Gjergj Fishta was a great patriot and above all he was one of the greatest inspiring Albanians. His verses inspired whole generations on the path to gaining freedom and independence. Fishta's "Lahuta" became a reference of the ideals for the fair struggle for the integrity and sovereignty of the Albanians...", said Tafa. "However, said Tafa, Fishta and his work did not always have a path paved with flowers, because he was condemned by the regime of monist Albania. Two dictatorships came together against him: the dictatorship of Albania and Yugoslavia.

"He was convicted and his writing was banned," Tafa said.

While, the director of the Albanian Institute of Sociology, at the same time professor at the University "Aleksandër Moisiu" in Durrës, spoke about the role of Fishta as a representative of social sciences and humanities.

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He began his speech by describing the 1985 Albanian Encyclopaedic Dictionary of Gjergj Fishta, according to whom Fishta was, among other things, "the leading representative of the Clerical reactionary literature who took an active part in cultural and political life to strengthen the positions of the Catholic clergy. He fought furiously against progressive ideas, hailed the occupation of Albania by fascist Italy and "Lahuta e Malcisë" is a poetic panorama of historical events from the Albanian League of Prizren to independence reflected by the positions of the Catholic clergy. Gjergj Fishta anthemized backwardness, patriarchy, ignorance. Raised mercenarism, etc. "

Sokoli said that this description of Fishta was intended to transfer the regime crime to science, in order to deny his role. "Fishta was the most cursed of the convicts," said Sokoli, "because he was required to be considered non-existent."

Even today there are rumors that take the assessment of Fishta even further than the position of the Dictionary of the Albanian Academy of Sciences of 1985, saying that Fishta was a collaborator of fascism, said Sokoli, underlining that this was the reason why the Albanian Institute of Sociology has declared 2021 as the year of Gjergj Fishta, as a moral and intellectual obligation.

Returning to the role and contribution of Gjergj Fishta, Sokoli said that Fishta is a universal intellectual, a prophetic personality of Albanian culture, writer, even as foreigners have called him the founder of an Albanian philosophical school. His creativity regardless of form is burdened by a philosophical weight. But his philosophy is a social philosophy, he observed the events of his time, reflected them in his creativity, but also reacted by holding an intellectual attitude. He was a man of action not just of creation, Sokoli emphasized.

The scientific promotional forum marking the 150th anniversary of the birth of Gjergj Fishta, continued with references of other participants, such as Prof. Dr. Xhavit Beqiri, who spoke about the language and style of Gjergj Fishta in his writing.

This activity also promoted the set of works of Gjergj Fishta, by the Publishing House "Gjergj Fishta" and two new titles "Father Gjergj Fishta: places-yearsworks" and "Gjergj Fishta Theater" by authors Tonin Çobani and Ndue Ballabani.

Faculty of Architecture of AAB College, now part of the "Urban Data Kosovo" an American project of the Massachusetts Institute of Technology

The Faculty of Architecture of AAB College is going to be part of the "Urban Data Kosovo" project, which is funded by the US Embassy in Prishtina and administered by KUSA, which is organized by KAF (Kosovo Foundation for Architecture).





On the occasion of the start of the project, Rector Bujar Demjaha and representatives of the Faculty of Architecture of AAB College, in a meeting, received the representative of the Center for Advanced Urbanism from the Massachusetts Institute of Technology (MIT), Professor Sarah Williams, and Mr. Bekim Ramku, director of the NGO KAF (Kosovo Foundation for Architecture).

The main objective of "Urban Data Kosovo" is the exchange of advanced urbanism expertise by researchers and academic staff of MIT with the academic staff of the faculties of architecture in Kosovo. The purpose of this program is to bring new knowledge on urban data collection, training and information exchange in Kosovo universities.



The project has now started, and the first phase sets off with the meeting of the project leaders with the institutions that will be involved in this project. The following phase of the project is the visit of the Kosovar academic staff to the USA, to the center for advanced urbanism, MIT; continuing with several weekly workshops in Kosovo, while the entire project is scheduled to be completed in July 2022.

The main result of this project is the reflection in the existing curricula in the faculties of architecture in Kosovo, in particular the subjects of urbanism, with a focus on the integration of contemporary spatial analytical tools and methodologies.

The second virtual scientific conference organized by AAB College concludes successfully

Over 100 participants from the country, region and the world presented about 80 scientific papers in the second international scientific conference, which was held virtually at AAB College.





The conference "Westernization, Europeanization and identity formation in the Western Balkan countries" was considered very important as Kosovo is learning the journey of countries that are already members of the European Union.

At the opening of the conference, the Rector of AAB College, Bujar Demjaha said that such events prove the commitment and one of the major priorities of AAB College for the development of science.

"I believe that this conference will give a great contribution outside the borders of Kosovo because the topic is complex and somehow covers the territory of Southeast Europe," said Demjaha.



The Vice-Rector for Scientific Research, Uranela Demaj, also spoke about the importance of the conference, saying that this conference becomes even more important because it brings together some very prominent partners from abroad, mainly from the European Union, while for the first time in the history of AAB College, we also have the University of Bologna as a partner.

The conference is important because it conveys the message of unity and internationalization, Demaj said.

While the Vice Rector for International Cooperation, Venera Llunji, speaking about the organization of this conference, emphasized her expected results.

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"It is very important for us to see what are the approaches that influence and help strengthen the identity of a country, taking into account that Kosovo is a new country. It needs to create its identity, which means we need to see what paths Kosovo takes to be a strong country in all its aspects, "said Llunji.

It should be noted that in the plenary session of the conference, which aroused the interest of the participants, well-known names of science from prestigious universities in the world were referred to, such as: Prof. dr. Raymond Detrez, Ghent University from Belgium, Prof. dr. Pal Kolsto, University of Oslo from Norway, Prof. dr. Ines Aquile Junyent, Catalonia University from Spain, and Prof. assoc. dr. Besnik Pula, Virginia Tech, from the United States.





The conference "Westernization, Europeanization and identity formation in the Western Balkan countries" was held in 11 separate panels, which addressed, in scientific terms, issues related to politics, economics, culture, identity, art, etc.

Debate by AJK at AAB College: Fake news and verification of facts during the Covid-19 pandemic

The students continued their journey of study visit in Suhareka, where they met Gresa Kuqi, a young entrepreneur with a lot of potential and enthusiasm, who shared her extraordinary family experiences related to the production company Solid, which is one of the very few shoe production companies in Kosovo. We have worked hard to make our Kosovo known to foreign companies like #Geox #Valentino, with whom we collaborate and also produce their brands, she said.

Students, in addition to hearing the success story of Mrs. Kuci, had the opportunity to see an extraordinary factory where more than 70 people work, a considerable number of which were women.

Students of AAB College were trained on doing business by well-known experts as part of #GEW21

11 November 2021

Within Global Entrepreneurship Week #gewkosovo2021, at AAB College, for the students of the Faculty of Economics, a one-day workshop was held, which aimed to increase and develop the skills of students in order to draft business plans, to be aware of the budget process in the Republic of Kosovo, as well as to know specifically the legal basis of business-doing in Kosovo.

The experts who were invited to this training for students, also shared their concrete experiences related to the topics, as well as practical examples of business registration, drafting business plans, for which students had the opportunity to implement specific exercises and tasks regarding the topics.

Such training and workshops will continue in the future, for the purpose of increasing the capacity of students and providing important information, so that they have much easier access to materialization of knowledge gained during the study.

Roundtable held on the transformation of Kosovo's traditional economy into a digital one

12 November 2021

In order to address as comprehensively and structurally as possible a topic so current, especially in the last decade, AAB College in the framework of the traditional activity of Global Entrepreneurship Week #GEW2021 #gewkosovo2021, hosted a roundtable discussion where panelists and students debated on the topic "Transformation of the economy in Kosovo from the traditional to the digital. Is the entrepreneurial approach in Kosovo changing?!".





Opening the discussion, Dean Medain Hashani said that digital transformation refers to the application of information technology and digital resources to turn these resources into new business models.

Arian ZEKA, Executive Director of the American Chamber of Commerce, stressed that digitalization, among other things, means a new world of opportunities.

Permanent technological innovations and business globalization enable the creation of a new business infrastructure, which, with the intensive application of Information and Communication Technologies, directly affects the creation of new business models.



Traditional businesses also need financial and human resources to transform them by applying innovative business models that are based on internet technologies, said Zeka.

Ilir Rexhepi, professor at the Faculty of Economics, said that in terms of digital transformation, Kosovo's economy has significant differences depending on the nature of the field of activity, business size and the sector in which it operates.

Rexhepi stressed that the management of Kosovar companies, on which the burden of digitalization falls, invests more in digital solutions than in the sustainability and functional security of their selected digital platforms. He concluded by emphasizing that Kosovo's economy is being transformed into a digital one, born out of a necessity to survive the current business climate, rather than as an innovative and objective business process strategically planned and well-supported institutionally.

Albulenë Kastrati, professor at AAB College, highlighted the challenges in Kosovo in the context of economic digitalization, such as the unfavorable climate for start-ups, both in terms of access to finance (non-financing by banks), and in terms of lack of technological skills for launching a business. As such, we get the digitalization of the economy based mainly on private initiatives such as ICK, Digital School, StarLabs. Kastrati also stressed the lack of a comprehensive state strategy for the digitalization of the entire economy and the lack of a strategy for orienting young people towards the skills required in the market and areas that bring employment prospects, such as studying in STEM fields.

Professor Lulzim Shabani addressed the process of digitalization of businesses from several perspectives. "New digital technologies inspire and promote the emergence of start-up companies, which with new business models create new industries and change existing ones. It is estimated that in the next ten years, 40% of companies will disappear from the market as a result of not changing or adapting to new digital trends."

Melita Ymeraga, founder of "Melita & Partners" highlighted a very important aspect in the digitalization process, or more precisely the main barrier which hinders the process of digitalization of businesses in Kosovo – the lack of digital skills of the workforce – human resources.

At the end of the discussion, the panelists answered the questions of the participating students, which mainly had to do with the challenges of the digitalization process that Kosovar enterprises are going through.

Roundtable "Entrepreneurship through accounting" held at AAB College

12 November 2021

AAB College, in cooperation with the AAB Institute for Certified Accountants and Auditors, organized a roundtable discussion with students of the Faculty of Economics on the topic "Entrepreneurship through accounting".



This roundtable, which took place in the framework of the activities for marking the Global Entrepreneurship Week (#GEW2021 #gewkosovo2021), provided important information for students on how they can, through their accounting skills and qualifications, develop their businesses.

Professor Medain Hashani, Dean of the Faculty of Economics and Professor of Accounting, showed the importance of accounting and the information that accounting experts provide on the performance of enterprises.





He said that in our country, mainly accountants work in tax accounting, but when it comes to the performance of companies, managerial, project and financial accounting are much more important.

According to Mrs. Fiknete Balaj, the second most demanded profession in the world is that of accounting, after IT professionals.

To create an accounting business, you need to be a professional, have experience, competence, determination, courage and professional networking.





Teuta Doli, founder of AEP accounting services company, spoke about the challenges in setting up businesses that provide accounting services. She also mentioned the lack of experience, the difficulties in convincing the clients to receive the services, the lack of practical knowledge, etc.

Former AAB College student, entrepreneur Drin Berisha, discusses his successful business journey with students

12 November 2021

Entrepreneur Drin Berisha of Kema Pak company from Ferizaj was the next guest in the discussion with the students of AAB College in the Ferizaj branch.

In this discussion held in the framework of the activities of the Global Entrepreneurship Week, the entrepreneur Drin Berisha talked about the beginnings of his idea for the creation of such a packaging enterprise.



He explained the founding of this company by saying that there is no such packaging company in Kosovo, and product packaging services are always imported from countries in the region, at a much higher cost.

What inspired Drin the most to initiate this business was the idea of creating new jobs and giving young people the opportunity to put into practice the knowledge they gained during their studies.

Berisha also spoke about the challenges he has faced as a manufacturing company, where he mentioned the pandemic, Covid-19, which complicated customs procedures, and in turn affected the performance of the company.



However, according to him, they are working hard so they can utilize recycled paper in order to reduce the need for importing the raw materials for packaging from other countries.

Drin, as a former student of AAB College, showed once again that from AAB College come students prepared for the labor market who have all the skills to become very successful. Drin also had a motivational message for the students, saying: "Never give up despite what difficulties you face. Work hard to realize your dreams".





Motivational discussion "Facetime with a Manager" was held with Proex leader, Ylber Kuraja

13 November 2021

Owing to the cooperation with the American Chamber of Commerce, a motivational discussion took place at the Media Center of AAB College, where the guest speaker was Mr. Ylber Kuraja, CEO of ProEx.

Mr. Kuraja, as one of the most successful managers in Kosovo, talked about the challenges and personal experiences in his business journey.





One thing that Mr. Kuraja talked about during his discussion was the "Law of Sacrifice", which according to him, thanks to this law, he has become a successful trader, but also stressed that in order to achieve success, you must work smart and hard.

Mr. Kuraja also advised students who in the future aim to become managers, saying: aim to become part of the 10% not the 80%, think different.





This can be achieved through three key points: defining the long-term goal, using the calendar, and keeping track of it, and lastly checking whether we are achieving our goals based on the calendar. This way we will perform as well and efficiently as possible, as managers, said Kuraja.

Mr. Kuraja said to the students that a manager is not born but you become through dedication and willpower, and that there is no ideal manager. A successful manager is one who produces other managers. He also added that to get a job as a manager, work experience is not as important as doing the job much better than you were told to.

This meeting with Mr. Kuraja was concluded with a questions and answers session by the students, who asked the three characteristics of a successful manager in terms of character are. Mr. Kuraja gave a definite and clear answer: sincerity, discipline and curiosity.

Why do some people refuse to be vaccinated? The debate lasted 90 minutes and was carefully monitored by the professors.

The jury declared the team who argued for the vaccination the winner and gave the students tips on how to improve their debating skills.

"If I did not know that I am in Kosovo, I would have thought that I am in a university institution in Norway or Finland", said at the beginning of his lecture President Ilir Meta, expressing his awe for the investments made in AAB College. In his lecture "Albanians as a factor of stability in the Balkans," President Meta stressed that the rule of law, democratic values, and Euro-Atlantic integration are the only way forward for Kosovo and Albania.





He expressed doubts about the Open Balkan initiative, calling it a diminutive initiative to the Berlin Process and worries about Serbia's approach.

The focus of his lecture was also the economic-trade obstacles between Kosovo and Albania, where he mentioned that Albanians in both Albania and Kosovo should reject any path that steers away from the Euro-Atlantic integration.

President Meta also paid special attention to the concern about the departure of young people from Kosovo and Albania, noting that Albania is late on its way to membership in the European Union. Today's lecture by Albanian President Ilir Meta was followed by a session of questions and answers, where Mr. Meta met with and answered questions the students might have had.


For the second year in a row, AAB College participates in the great jury of European Universities for selecting the best film in the European University Film Award category (EUFA)

Cyber security expert holds online lecture for AAB College students



"The unfinished trial of Slobodan Milosevic" by author Nevenka Tromp promoted at AAB College

"I think this book is fantastic baggage for those who want to delve into political developments and learn about the crimes of the past so we are not doomed to repeat them", said Demjaha.



The author of this book, Nevenka Tromp, has talked about her efforts and the challenges she has gone through until she finished the book. "This book is a work of about six years. I would wake up and go to the office to look for and review all the material from Milosevic's trial. In the beginning, I had no idea what I was doing and was not sure about the concept or the time period I wanted to include in the book.





I was told that Slobodan Milosevic was dead, however to me, this was no reason to stop but, rather continue to understand the truth. "This book is your story," she said.

Guests Furtuna Sheremeti and Robert Muharremi spoke about the importance and connection of the country's policies with the book.





"If not challenged from alternative perspectives, Serbia's control over the post-conflict narrative could leave Serbia with a cleaner history than it deserves, allowing post-conflict elites to pursue the ideology of uniting all Serbs. Dr. Tromp has managed to expose the political dimensions of international criminal justice as reflected in Croatia, Bosnia, and Kosovo. The train has not stopped yet," said Mr. Muharram.

Whereas, Furtuna Sheremeti spoke more about the consequences of the past, saying that the past still haunts her.

"It is an expression in the Albanian language that I keep in my heart: "Never Forget". This approach is one of the reasons why people in Kosovo still remember and cling to the past, but it also risks becoming exactly the reason why people leave the country because a worse fate could eventually befall them—thus making them forget the real reason the war was fought in the first place. And this is a scenario that no country should allow to happen," she said.

At the end of the promotion, Tromp answered questions from students and other participants.


The students were very active with their questions and comments throughout the discussion.


Some of the methods that were also touched on during the lecture were the method of decreasing cash flow and the method of increasing dividends.

Among other things, Dr. Ismail Nizam highlighted the main benefits of digitalization, such as the ease of providing services by banks, better financial reports and better relationships with customers.

At the end of the discussion, prof. Nizam testified through empirical evidence that the digitalization of banking services in the time of the pandemic was the savior of a deeper financial crisis.
